Encourage your child to take care of personal hygiene. Help him/ her


- Brush teeth twice a day.

- Shelling out peas
- Scribbling on newspapers using crayons only
- Tearing and pasting of papers
- Kneading the dough and rolling the clay
- Picking up and holding onto small objects



ROCK PAINTING-


Let's explore mother nature. Collect medium Size Marble or stone, and paint them to give a vibrant look




ACTIVITY 6




