CHEMISTRY Holiday Homework

TASK 1

Knowledge of acids and bases is essential for a wide range of everyday activities, from cleaning and cooking to personal care and health. It helps you make informed choices, understand chemical reactions, and stay safe in various situations.

Research and prepare a report on why knowing about acids and bases is important in everyday life.

TASK 2

ACTIVITY: -To check the presence of acid, base, salt and indicators in the items of daily use.

1. Take some household items such as lemon juice, bitter gourd juice, tomato juice/sauce, colourless aerated drink, tap water, toothpaste, baking soda solution, vinegar, baking powder, and common salt.

- 2. Prepare your own natural indicator using either red cabbage leaves or turmeric.
- 3. Categorize/Tabulate the samples taken as acidic, basic and salty on the basis of taste.
- 4. Test each sample with the prepared natural indicator and tabulate the observations in terms of change in colour.

- 5. Take pH paper and dip it in each sample. Record the colour change and compare it with the pH scale. Note the pH value and classify each as acidic, basic or neutral.
- 6. Take 1-2 ml lemon juice and bitter gourd juice in separate containers. Put a few drops of diluted vanilla essence or clove oil. Note down the difference in odour before and after adding vanilla essence or clove oil.

- Materials: Clay, playdough, modeling clay, or craft supplies.

 Properties of Metals vs. Non-Metals: Create a comparative model displaying the physical and chemical properties of metals versus non-metals. For example, you can showcase metals' lustre, malleability, and conductivity compared to nonmetals' properties like brittleness and lack of conductivity.

 Reactivity Series Model: Create a visual representation of the reactivity series, which lists metals in order of their reactivity.
 You can use different metals to demonstrate their reactivity with acids or water. For instance, magnesium reacts vigorously with dilute hydrochloric acid, while copper does not react.

Acid Rain Simulation Model: Build a model to demonstrate
the effects of acid rain on the environment. Use vinegar to
simulate acid rain and observe its effects on materials like
limestone (calcium carbonate) or metal objects. This model
helps to illustrate the environmental impact of acid deposition
and the importance of understanding acid-base chemistry in
pollution control

Roll Num 26-30

Electrolysis of Saltwater Model: Set up an electrolysis
apparatus using a battery, electrodes, and a solution of
saltwater (sodium chloride). When electricity is passed through
the solution, chlorine gas is produced at the anode, and
hydrogen gas is produced at the cathode. This model
demonstrates the electrolysis of salts and the decomposition of
water.

TASK 2: Design a colourful and innovative game board featuring themes allotted according to your roll numbers.

Roll no. 31-35

Keeping in mind various life processes-themed landmarks, such as a nutrition centre, a fitness zone, a sleep sanctuary, and a stress relief oasis. Create challenge cards with scenarios related to biology and mental health.
