Make a story book.

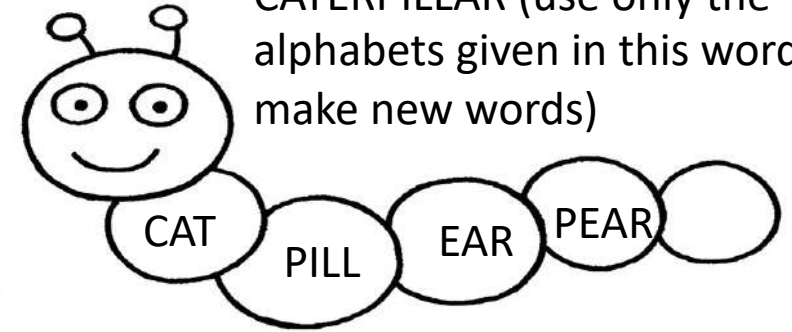
Write a small story about trees, animals, river (nature based). Write a story on one side, and draw or paste related pictures on the other side.

PROJECT (I-A)

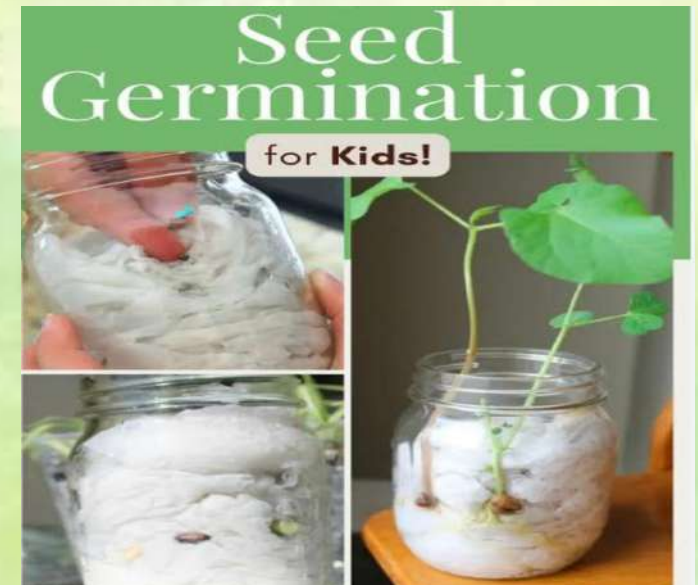
Research Project

Put on your research cap and find out how people in different parts of the world are living. Using different material available at home prepare a model of any one type of house. Decorate the house with recycled products. Also learn to speak 3-4 lines on the type of house chosen.



PROJECT (I-B)

Germinate few seeds of black gram/ red kidney beans on a layer of moist cotton in a disposable bowl. Observe the changes for 8 to 10 days and record them on a paper. Keep the cotton moist. Click their progress each day and then make a collage on A3 sheet of your progress mentioning days like day 1, day 2 etc.



PROJECT (I-C)

Choose your favourite Festival and prepare a WORD MAT on an A3 plain sheet. The child can write and draw any 10 words related to the festival chosen. This will help the child develop vocabulary and understanding of the various festivals. Also laminate your word mat.



PROJECT (I-D)

Prepare 4 Stick Puppets of your choice (2 animals and 2 birds) using broom sticks/ice cream spoons/straws etc. Note: Use cut outs of different Shapes (circle, rectangle, oval, square, triangle etc.) and of different sizes to make the stick puppets.



PROJECT (I-E)

Make a creative model of an animal using shoe box /tooth paste box / any other type of sturdy carton.



PROJECT (I-F)

Make 2 eco-friendly paper bags (of big size) using old newspaper or brown paper (Thick). Write a slogan on " Save Environment" on it & decorate it beautifully.



PROJECT 7 (I-G)

-Make a telephone diary using papers from the old notebooks. Decorate with pics from old wedding cards & greeting cards. Write phone no. of your parents/grandparents, neighbours, fire brigade, police station, family doctor, friends and any one agency where we can send leftover food for the needy.



PROJECT (I-H)

A bird feeder activity involves creating and using a bird feeder to attract birds and observe their behaviour. It can help provide a safe environment for birds to easily access a food source, water and habitat. Make a bird feeder using sustainable materials like used bottles, coconut shells, wood, straw etc.



Art and Craft

- I-A Take a stone of medium size. Paint it and decorate it to make it useful as a paper weight.
- I-B Choose any cartoon character. Draw it on ivory sheet. Paint it and make a cut out of it. It should be at least 10 inches long.
- I-C Draw a flower vase on an ivory sheet and make 3D flowers on it. Decorate it beautifully.
- I-D Take a plate and decorate it as a "Pooja Thali". Paste one diya on it.
- I-E Make a beautiful Kattputli (Puppet). Size should be at least 10 inches long.
- I-F Make a cut out of an animal on A-3 size sheet. Do tearing and pasting activity to complete it.
- I-G Make a beautiful folder by using handmade sheet (Size 10 X 14 inches).
- I-H Make and decorate any-4 beautiful gift envelopes or greeting cards.
