Dear Parents/Students,

As you are aware that Half Yearly Examination are going to commence in September, here are few important guidelines and related information for the same.

- General Knowledge exam for all the classes (V to XII) will be held on Monday, September 02, 2024. This exam will include objective type questions only and will be held within the school hours. Regular classes will be held after the exam. It will be a full-fledged working day for all the students.
- On Thursday, September 05, 2024, school timings for all the students will be from 8 am – 11.30 am, on the occasion of Teachers' Day Celebration.
- Students will be having Preparatory Leaves from September 06 – 08, 2024.
- Timings during Half Yearly Examination days will be 8 am – 11.55 am. Parents are requested to make arrangements for safe pick and drop of their wards accordingly.
- School buses will ply at usual timings in the morning and at 12 noon in afternoon, during examination days.
- Days in between exam days will be considered as Preparatory Leaves.

- Items not permitted inside the examination room are calculators, mobiles, smart watches, any electronic gadgets, notebooks, books and bags.
- Students must refrain from using any unfair means during examination. In case any student is found using any unfair means, his/her exam may be cancelled.
- Students are advised to have proper breakfast before coming to school.
- Students must prepare for the exams with utmost sincerity and attempt the exam with honesty and sincerity. All the best!!
