How to make -


- Form all the letters a to z as shown in the on different A4 size sheets

What all you need-A4 size pastel sheets scissors sketch pens, colours



How to make -

- Cut 26 small circles out of coloured pastel sheet
- Write the small and capital letter as shown in the image on each circle.
- Cut a strip and paste the circle in the centre of the strip
- Draw 4 small pictures on each strip of paper and colour them all.
- Laminate the same using broad cello tape.
- Refer to the image and the shared link.

What all you need-

- A4 size pastel sheets
- scissors
- White sheet
- sketch pens, colours
- Colourful clothes hanging clips\pegs.

How to make -

- Cut 9 circles of size (10cm diameter) out of coloured pastel sheet and 9 small circles (7cm diameter) with white sheet as well.
- Write the numbers from (1-9) on white sheet as shown in the image on each circle.
- Now paste the white circles on the colourful circles.
- Laminate the same using broad cello tape.
- Refer to the image and the shared link.
