LANGUAGE SKILL: ENGLISH

1. <u>Nature's Canvas</u>

The students will go on Nature Walk with their parents or grandparents. They will collect fallen leaves (of different sizes), twigs, straws etc. and make a scenery out of it. The students will describe their scenery in few sentences in the class. (To be made on A-3 size sheet.)





2. Songs of Sun and Soil

The students will learn a poem/song on the theme 'Wonders of Nature' and recite it on the school stage with related props after holidays.



Sound Flash Cards

The students will prepare **three flash Cards** each on different sound blends according to their Roll Numbers. (You can take help from 'My English Reader')

Instructions:

- ✓ Use a thick paper or a cardboard. (Size half A-4 size sheet)
- ✓ Make it bright and colourful.
- ✓ Paste the sound word and label it.



Roll No. 1 to 7: 'ar' sound like car, jar etc.

Roll No. 8 to 14: 'ai' sound like tail, pair etc.

Roll No. 15 to 21: 'ou' sound like house, mouse etc.

Roll No. 22 to 28: 'tch' sound like patch, watch etc.

Roll No. 31 to 35: 'wh' sound like whale, whip etc.


Roll No. 36 to 46: 'oa' sound like coat, soap etc.

- 36-46 Assam


COGNITIVE SKILL: MATHEMATICS

Number Bug (Slider)

The students will write 0-9 on three different strips and then create 3 windows on a different strip and will slide into the said number to strengthen the concept of place value.

Roll number 24-46

Use different sizes/types of leaves and acrylic paints for <mark>leaf printing on a paper/cloth bag</mark>. Be a curious creator and create your own masterpiece. (Reference pictures on the class group.)

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

Take a print out of the worksheets given for each subject and encourage the child to do it independently. Put them in a folder and send them along with the Holiday Homework and submit it by 07 July,2025.

- Ensure that the child does the Homework neatly on his own under your guidance and supervision.
- Originality of work would be appreciated.
- Try to converse in English with the children (You can start with the basic sentences).
- Give them regular practice to improve their handwriting.
- Encourage them to use the golden words like Sorry, Thank You and Please.
- Engage them in constructive activities. Set a time table with compulsory SCREEN FREE TIME.
- Be a Good Storyteller encourage your child to read as many story books as possible in English as well as Hindi language and narrate them to you and your family.
- Be a friend, motivator and guide to the kids during the break.
