



English


1. **Create a Story – “The Glacier’s Secret”:**(For Roll No. 1 to 12) ----Write a short story in your own words on A3 size-sheet about magical glacier that sends a message to humans. Roll it like an old scroll, burn the edges (with adult help) or use tea-stained paper for effect.



2. **Poster Making with 3D Effects and Slogan:**Design a colourful poster with a catchy slogan on “Save the Glaciers” on A3 size sheet. Use bright colours, cotton for snow, blue foil or paper for ice and rivers, add pop-out elements for mountains or melting glaciers to make it attractive and be imaginative as possible for “NAVORJA EXHIBITION”.
3. **Acrostic Poem “ GLACIER”:**(For Roll No. 13 to 24) --- Paint flat stones or cardboard cutouts. Write an **acrostic poem** using the word GLACIER. Decorate each stone with icy blue, white, and silver patterns for “NAVORJA EXHIBITION”. For e.g. –

4. **Frozen Fact Fortune Wheel:**(For Roll No. 25 to 36) --- Make the base as a wheel and divide it into 6 to 8 equal segments like a pizza. In each segment, write **1 glacier-related fact**. Make a spinner arrow and attach it in a centre. Decorate the wheel using cotton balls to look like snow, blue/white/silver colours to give it a for **“NAVORJA EXHIBITION”**.

5. **Frozen Feelings – If a Glacier had emotions...** (For Roll No. 37 onwards) --- Make a colourful chart showing how a glacier would feel in different situations (melting, being polluted, admired by tourists). Decorate your chart with cotton to show snow effect, use glitter or foil for icy effects. You can also draw the glacier as a big face at the top, reacting to each emotion. For e.g. -

Activity 1


Save the Glaciers – Awareness Poster (Roll no. 1 to 12)

Materials Required:

A3 sheet/chart paper, sketch pens, crayons, pencil, eraser

Steps:

1. Draw a glacier scene with mountains, ice, and water.
2. Add animals (like polar bears or snow leopards) to show the ecosystem.
3. Write a catchy slogan: e.g., “Cold Today, Gone Tomorrow!”
4. Color and decorate the poster.
5. Share 2–3 facts about glacier preservation on the side.



Activity 2

Collage Making on – “Glaciers in News” (Roll no.13 to25)

Materials Required:

Chart paper, glue, scissors, old newspapers/magazines

Activity 4

Activity 5

Model Activity: 3D Glacier Model (Roll no 37 onwards)



Materials Required: Cardboard base, Cotton (for snow), Blue cellophane paper or plastic (for water), Small stones, white paper, glue, Toy animals (optional)

Steps:

1. Use the cardboard as your base.
2. Build mountains using rolled newspaper or clay. Cover with cotton.
3. Use blue paper to show rivers formed by melting glaciers.
4. Add stones and toy animals (e.g., polar bears, deer).
5. Label parts: glacier, river, mountain, animal, etc.



ACTIVITY-1

Create an "Ice Stupa: Nature's Water Towers"(Roll no. 1 to 15)

Ice Stupas are innovative, man-made ice structures designed to store water in cold, arid regions like Ladakh, India. They serve as **artificial glaciers**. The concept was pioneered by **Sonam Wangchuk**, an Indian engineer and innovator from Ladakh.

- Read about ice stupas and their significance in regions like Ladakh.
- Use chart paper or cardboard to create a sturdy base for your model.
- Decorate the base to resemble the natural environment (e.g., mountains, rivers).
- Form a cone shape using paper or use an inverted plastic bottle.
- Secure it to the base using glue or tape.
- Cover the cone with cotton, tissue paper, or paint it white to mimic ice.



ACTIVITY-2-

Glacier Preservation Poster (Roll no- 16 to 30)

Make a poster to Promote awareness about glacier preservation on an A3 sheet. Research the importance of glaciers and threats they face. Design a poster illustrating the significance of glaciers and ways to protect them. Include slogans like "Save Our Glaciers" or "Protect the Ice Giants."

- ❖ **Make your poster meaningful, catchy, bright and colourful.**

ACTIVITY-3

Poster Title: "Guardians of the Glaciers!" (Roll no. 36 onwards)

1. **Don't Waste Energy:** Leaving devices on wastes electricity.
2. **Avoid Single-Use Plastics:** They often end up polluting natural habitats.

WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY


Activity- Create a poster on "Reduce, Reuse and Recycle"
